1. COUNCIL AGENDA /ISSUES/WORK UPDATES:

GARDEN- Charles Bryant AKA Tad

COMMUNITY CENTER- Donita Bowen, Ice Maker needs a filtration system. Calcium buildup may be causing the tripping of it and not making ice properly. New machine may be needed.

ROADS AND APPEARANCE- David Evans, signs picked up by Tad. Need to decide on how to place them... Request for bids to set them. Trimming Tree at Candy Cane & Sleigh?

2. OLD BUSINESS:

- Out of Compliance Tax returns/Audits. Still working on this... Bishop Associates has worked very hard with Ms. Sue and let the council know when it is complete. Year 2015 will have to be audited due to the amount spent. Sue any update on these?

3. NEW BUSINESS:

- 2021 is an election year for us for 2022 elected Council members. 2 Seats will be open. David Evans, who took my seat in 2020 and Monte Powell. The Qualifying cost \$18.00 and though it doesn't have to be paid till August 20. We still have to legally announce it now. So please keep that in mind, and we will remind you of that as we get closer to the date.
